It lies within the multidimensional, complex and connective relationships between people as they establish networks, co-ordinate power relations and re-configure identities through changing work environments. Brokering Change is a concept used to inform research into learning and evaluation in post-compulsory adult education contexts. For both individuals and institutions operating at the interface of policy and practice, change is brokered through engagements with economic, social, technological and political dimensions of globalisation as enacted in diverse localised learning contexts.
