Prof. Dr. Dr. Feyzi ULUG is born in 1957. He completed his primary and secondary education in schools in Ankara. He studied for diploma vocational and technical education in the Industrial Arts Higer School for Teachers. Completed his B.A. in psychological guidance and counselling services in Ankara University. He studied for M.A. in the same area, and had a M.P.A in the Institute of Public Administration for Turkey and the Middle East (TODAIE).
